studied chemistry of lactic acid; analyzed constitution of proteins and was the first to characterize well-defined protein hydrolysis products; investigated phosphate-containing compounds in muscle; studied reaction of carbonic acid with amino acids, alcohols, oxyacids, and sugars.

FOOTNOTE: After obtaining his PhD in organic chemistry under Wislicenus, Siegfried served as Drechsel's assistant for four years at the Leipzig Physiological Institute. Siegfried's interest in physiology dates from this appointment.
