studied the synthesis and reactions of ketones, esp. benzophenone derivatives; investigated chemistry of haloethanes and tertiary amines; measured the density and molecular weight of ozone; first to prepare crystalline hydroperoxides; discovered that the boiling points and specific volumes of organic substances are correlated.

FOOTNOTE: Staedel also studied for two semesters in Heidelberg with Bunsen and Kirchhoff in 1861 and for three semesters in Wiesbaden with Fresenius in 1862-63.
