professor of anatomy and surgery; described anatomy of rare animals such as elephants, leopards, and lions; established that certain large bones found in Siberia belonged to the mammoth and not to an elephant; described the native flora of Tübingen.

FOOTNOTE: Duvernoy studied under Tournefort during a visit to Paris in 1708; Duvernoy's teachers in Tübingen are not identified.
