studied beta particle and gamma-ray emission by radioactive nuclei and established existence of energy levels in the nucleus; obtained key evidence of energy deficit in certain nuclear reactions, which led to Fermi's postulation of the neutrino; first to point out that rest mass of neutrinos is probably zero; measured gamma-ray photoelectron spectra of U, Pb, Pt, W, Ba, and Ra; scientific advisor to Britain's National Coal Board and Gas Council.
