professor of philosophy and mathematics; noted German epigrammist; studied differential equations, spherical geometry, spherical aberration, and various other topics in geometry, algebra, calculus, astronomy, and optics; promoted interest among mathematicians in searching for a proof of Euclid's parallel postulate; teacher of Gauss, Olbers, and Wolfgang Bolyai.
