surgeon, anatomist, physiologist, obstetrician; also taught forensic medicine and natural history; specialist in surgical procedures involving the head and face, esp. harelips; founded a journal for surgery, obstetrics, and forensic pharmacology; wrote influential handbooks and atlases of anatomy and surgery; helped set-up a modern hospital and medical institute in Moscow after the war of 1812; popularized Alanson's improved amputation procedure in Germany.
