Nobel Prize in Physics in 1952 (with Bloch) for the discovery of NMR spectroscopy and other discoveries in connection with this work; investigated nuclear magnetism, esp. relaxation phenomena, related problems of molecular structure, measurement of atomic constants, and nuclear magnetic behavior at low temperatures; contributed to the field of radio astronomy.
