FOOTNOTE: Thorpe was an undergraduate at Oxford where Roscoe was Professor of Chemistry. Thorpe took Roscoe's advice and travelled to Bunsen's laboratories to further his education, but Thorpe's later research clearly owes more to Roscoe.
