professor of medicine, chemistry, and pharmacy; supervisor of the botanical garden at Griefswald University; director of the medical college; published first diagram of a counter current condenser; translated several of Lavoisier's works into German; wrote book on pure and applied chemistry that was one of the first to be meant for a general audience; also wrote texts on mineralogy, and the influence of chemistry on economics.
